# Background

- Maemo is deb based
- ...with differences (Maemo Packaging Policy):
  - Section
  - XB-Maemo-Icon
  - Hildonisation
  - UI screen changes
  - Version numbers
- Porters != upstream maintainers

# Porters' Options

- Maintain a fork?
  - p7zip, emacs-for-maemo, zip-unzip, motion, fuse, consoleutils, hugs, ...
- Get patches integrated upstream
- Keep patches unversioned locally
- Get a garage project to keep patches
- ...
- **mud-builder**

# Features

- Take source from upstream
  - Automatically Debianise, if necessary
  - Automatically Maemoify
  - Apply any patches
- Build
- Test
- Upload source package to auto-builder\*

\* not *quite* automatic yet...

# Features (continued)

- dh\_make + additions:
  - Recognises most basic source layouts
  - Automatic dependency handling
  - Handle bora/chinook/diablo SDK differences
  - Automatic “user/” section prefix
  - Icon image file to XB-Maemo-Icon header

# History

- Originally “Maemo Unofficial Debs”
  - Auto-builder
  - Patch management
  - Central project
- Now, just “**mud**”
  - ~~Auto builder~~
  - Patch management
  - Central project(?)

# Package Definition

- XML file
  - Package name
  - Source location
    - Tarball
    - Upstream deb-package
    - Command (e.g. svn)
  - Build information
  - Package information
- Optional icon
- Optional patches

## Example - bc

```
<package>
  <fetch type="debian"/>
</package>
```

- That's it.
- Build package with:

```
mud build bc
```

# Example - netcat

```
<package>
  <fetch type="tarball">
    <url>http://sourceforge.net/netcat-0.7.1.tar.bz2</url>
  </fetch>
  <deb>
    <icon>http://netcat.sourceforge.net/favicon.ico</icon>
    <description>
      TCP/IP swiss army knife\nA simple ...
    </description>
    <section>user/communication</section>
  </deb>
</package>
```

# Future – assistance welcome!

- Extras auto-builder changes things
  - (for the better!)
- New direction: focus on easing packaging
  - Revamp website & improve documentation
  - Simplify package signing & upload
  - Warn/error on Packaging Policy violations
  - Review existing packages
    - Upload good packages to Extras(-devel)
    - Use version control (svn del) for the others
